The Michigan Lead Abatement Act of 1998 (MCL 333.5451 to 333.5477) established the authority for the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS) to certify persons to perform lead-based paint (LBP) activities, accredit lead training courses and training providers, and monitor LBP activities for compliance. These functions are administered through the Healthy Homes Section (HHS).

On June 23, 2017, HHS Staff conducted an on-site audit investigation and on July 10, 2017 a record review investigation for the site referenced above. MDHHS has determined that conditions and work practice standards for the lead-based paint investigation at the above address comply with lead hazard remediation regulations.
